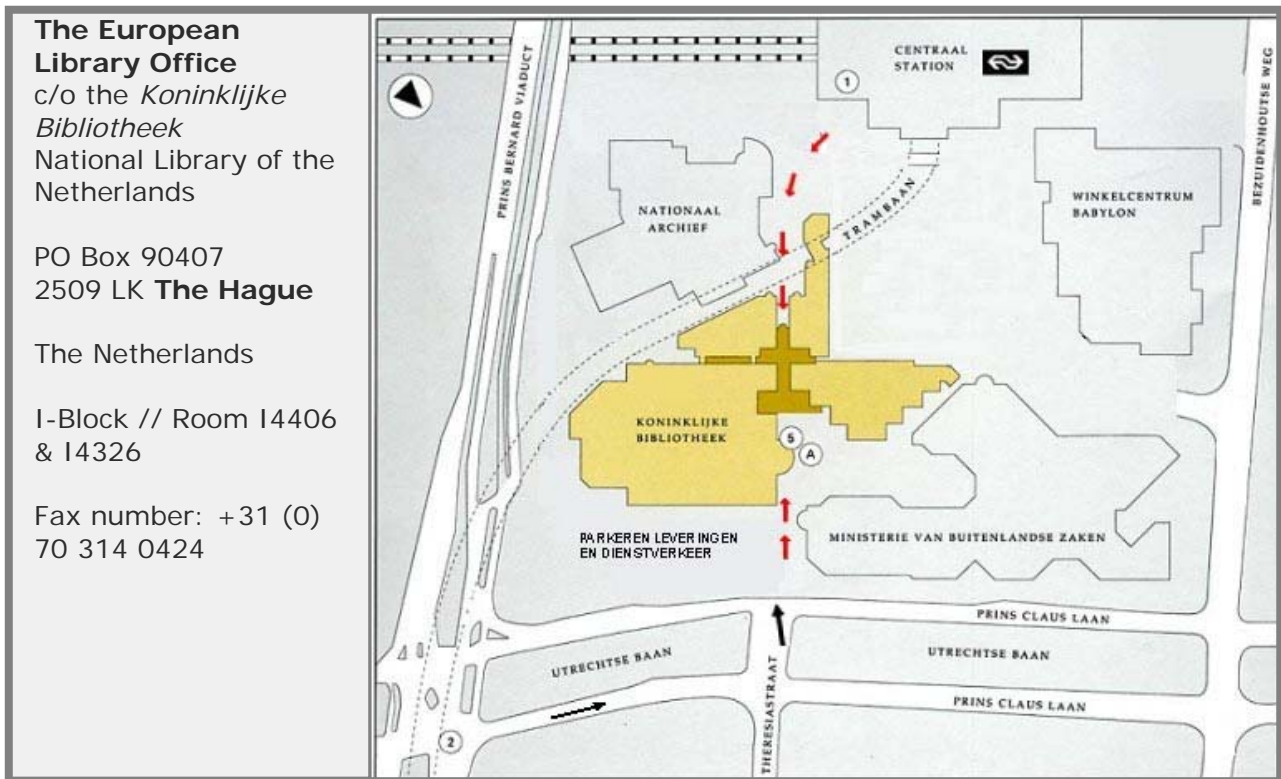

Driving

If you are planning to come by car, please contact The European Library office first, at least 24 hours before your visit. You will need to give your license plate number and estimated arrival time, so that we can reserve a space in the car park for you. Otherwise, there are several paying parking zones in the vicinity of the KB.

The bus and tram platforms are situated in the Central Station building. From the bus and tram platforms (located one floor above the train platforms) you can see the big white KB building.
