In internet computing, **SRW** (*Search/Retrieve Web service*) is a web service for search and retrieval. SRW provides a SOAP interface to queries, to augment the URL interface provided by its companion protocol SRU (*Search/Retrieve via URL*). Queries in SRU and SRW are expressed using the Common Query Language (CQL).

Standards for SRW, SRU, and CQL are promulgated by the United States Library of Congress.
