

EDLnet – Invitation for Expression of Interest

This is an open letter to invite submissions of an expression of interest to carry out work as described in the accompanying document ([EDLnet work description](#)) under any of the following Lots.

Lot 1 Technical and Semantic Interoperability and the resulting Technical and Logical Architecture as reflected by the work required in:

- SubLot 1.1 WP2 WG2.1 Standards and Interoperability
- SubLot 1.2 WP2 WG2.2 Semantic and multilingual interoperability
- SubLot 1.3 WP2 WG2.3 Technical Architecture

Submissions may be made for Lot 1 as a whole, or for sublots 1.1-1.3 individually or severally. The area being tendered for must be made clear in the expression of interest.

Lot 2 Concertation and Dissemination as described largely in WP4

Lot 3 Facilitation, mainly within WP1, but also between work packages.

It is envisaged that the work described would amount to the following person months of effort for each respective lot over the project duration of 24 months beginning 1st July 2007.
